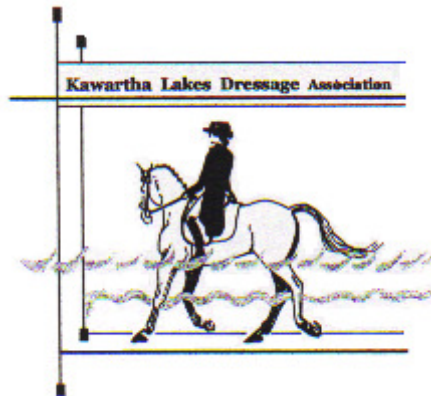

### Equine Canada Statement of Principle

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedures;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition;
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

Championship and Reserve Championships will be awarded for the Divisions listed below. Riders in EC divisions will compete and ride tests 2 & 3. Riders in the FEI divisions will ride the individual and team tests with the exception of Young Horses and Grand Prix per the details below. Two technical tests are ridden for each Division. The rider with the highest combined score, from the two tests, will be declared Champion. The rider with the second highest combined score will be declared Reserve Champion. Refer to 2011 Equine Canada Rules for Dressage, Section E. Horse and rider combinations may enter two consecutive levels.

In addition to the Ontario Champion and Reserve Champion, we will be awarding a show champion and reserve for all miscellaneous divisions.

**Criteria:**

The best technical class score from each day of competition will be totaled. A competitor must compete in no less than one test per day.

**Champion Determination:**

The competitor with the highest total detailed above will be declared champion. The competitor with the second highest total detailed above will be declared reserve champion.

**Fine Print:**

For a champion and reserve champion to be declared in a level, there must be at least three competitors that meet the minimum criteria.

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

**ENTRIES** – Entries close August 17, 2011 and will not be accepted unless accompanied by:

1. Photocopies of 2011 EC and DC membership cards for Rider & Owner
2. Photocopies of 2011 Provincial membership cards for Rider & Owner
3. Photocopy of 2011 Horse License Sticker (make a copy of passport)
4. Your signed waiver
5. Your accurate and complete entry form
6. Your current dated cheque, made payable to **Kawartha Lakes Dressage Assoc. or KLDA**

<b>Faxed</b> entries are subject to a \$35.00 service charge.	<b>Incomplete</b> entries are subject to a \$10.00 service charge at the discretion of the secretary
<b>Late</b> entries are subject to a \$40.00 late fee, and will only be accepted at the discretion of the Show Committee.	<b>Any cheques returned</b> by the bank for any reason, are subject to a \$60.00 fee.
The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse entries for any reason.	

<b>CLOSING DATE</b>	The closing date for entries is <b>August 17, 2011</b> .
<b>CATEGORIES</b>	Those wishing to compete in two categories (i.e. AA and Open) will pay two entry fees, but will ride one test; the score will count for both categories. If there are fewer than six (6) entries per category at any level the organizing committee has the option of holding only the open category or combining any two (2) categories together.
<b>CANCELLATIONS</b>	Cancellations will only be accepted with a Veterinarian/Doctor's Certificate. Refunds of 100% of class entry and stabling fees, less administration fee, will be allowed up until the closing date (Aug 17, 2011). Refunds of 50% of class entry fees, less administration fee, will be made after the closing date and before the start of the show. There will be no refunds on stabling fees after the closing date. Scratches after the show starts will lose the total entry and stabling fee.
<b>HORS CONCOURS</b>	Hors Concours entries will be accepted into miscellaneous classes at the discretion of the organizing committee and these entries will ride last in the class.
<b>PASSPORTS</b>	All competition horses and non-showing horses, must present a valid EC/FEI passport to the show secretary before receiving a number.
<b>NUMBERS</b>	All competition and non showing horses must wear a number at all times in the schooling and exercise areas and in the competition rings. Passports will be returned upon return of number.
<b>NON-SHOWING HORSES</b>	There is a \$150.00 charge for non-showing horses. Non-showing horses are subject to all the rules pertaining to competing horses.
<b>RIDING TIMES</b>	Riding times will be available at <a href="http://www.klda.ca">www.klda.ca</a> no later than August 31st, 2011.
<b>PRESENTATIONS</b>	There will be formal presentations for Championship Divisions, dressed and mounted. Competitors will be advised over the P.A. system as well as posted with scores.
<b>QUERIES</b>	Questions concerning rules, scoring or entries may be made to the Steward for discussion with the Organizing Committee. Protests must be made in writing within 48 hours of the completion of the class and accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00, cash or certified cheque. See EC Rules
<b>STABLING</b>	The cost per stall is \$170.00 or \$120.00 (see stabling form) for the duration of the competition, Thursday noon through Sunday 6 pm. There are no guarantees that the type of stall requested, tack or day stalls will be available even if booked with the entry. If a tack stall is unavailable, the competitor will be notified by the show secretary prior to Aug 31/10 and a full refund will be given. The order that stalls are filled is 1. Permanent Stabling, 2. Indoor Portable Stabling, 3. Tent stabling if requests exceed total available stabling already on site. While we try to accommodate all requests and work primarily on a first come basis, stabling assignment is at the discretion of the organizer. Stalls will not be bedded, please bring your own shavings or shavings will be

	available at \$9.00 per bag. Please bring your own hay, feed and buckets. Wednesday night or <b>earlier arrival by special request, \$50.00 extra per day or part thereof.</b>
<b>DRUG TESTING</b>	EC/FEI Drug and Medications rules apply at these shows. Any horse entered in any class at any competition may, while on the competition grounds, be selected for equine medication control testing.
<b>INSURANCE</b>	All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events is necessary.
<b>RIBBONS</b>	Ribbons will be presented to 6 <sup>th</sup> place as well as division champion and reserve champion except where noted otherwise.
<b>FREESTYLE MUSIC</b>	<b>Must be submitted when competitor package is picked up and on CD.</b>
<b>PARKING</b>	Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. There will be no parking on the roads and the barn areas at any time. After unloading, please do not park in the stable area.
<b>SECURITY</b>	Security will not be provided. The show organizers and the facility accept no responsibility for lost or stolen items. Please do not leave items unattended.
<b>DOGS</b>	If you must bring your furry friend, make sure 1. you stoop & scoop , 2. do not allow your friend to run loose, 3. you use a leash that can extend no longer than 2 metres. Penalties will be levied.
<b>Warm up</b>	<b>Warm up will be available as posted.</b> Competition rings will be open to riders on Thursday until 6 pm. After that time, competition rings may NOT be available for any reason. Please ensure that you wear your competition number at all times.

#### ADDITIONAL RULES SPECIFIC TO THE ONTARIO DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRIES/CLASSES

<b>HOW TO QUALIFY FOR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES</b>	Complete and submit the "Statement of Qualifying Scores" form with your entry. Please save paper, do NOT send copies of the tests unless specifically requested. Training through Fourth Level: Scores must be EITHER a) two posted scores from two different judges from two different Gold dressage competitions OR b) three posted scores from no less than 2 different judges at one Gold dressage competition. All scores should be a minimum of 53%. FEI Level: Two scores (minimum 53%) at the relevant level must be submitted. Freestyles: Please refer to the 2011 Rules of Equine Canada, Section E (Dressage). All scores must be obtained since September 1, 2010. Scores from Championship classes at the 2010 Ontario Dressage Championships will not count however non-championship classes at that show would count.
<b>WHIPS</b>	<b>MUST NOT BE CARRIED IN ANY CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS</b>
<b>TESTS</b>	<b>MUST NOT BE CALLED IN ANY CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS</b>
